Course Outline

The Travel and Tourism course is a work-related qualification that reflects the knowledge, skills and understanding required in the Travel and Tourism industry. The course addresses the key areas required for learners contemplating a career within the Tourism industry. The course is designed for learners who already have an interest in the Tourism industry but have not yet fully decided on a career path. The qualification will give learners the opportunity in due course to enter a role within the tourism sector, for example posts in travel agencies, visitor attractions and tourist information centre.
